Students

- **Commitment is Key!**

- Dedicate the time to attend every session.
 - Please plan to stay the whole time.
 - **Note: Rocketry participants may be required to attend additional or extended meetings and launches while competing in the rocketry competition.**
- Be proactive about contacting the 2.0 staff regarding your attendance. If you know you will be absent or need to leave early, let us know using the Remind messaging system.

- **Take Responsibility!**

- Arrive to meetings on time.
- Clean up and put away all materials before leaving.
- Take the time to complete all lab sheets and data records.
- Treat all participants with respect including teachers, STARBASE staff, mentors, volunteers, and your fellow participants.

- **Handle with Care!**

- Handle all equipment carefully and properly.
- When using laptop computers or iPads, use only the programs, features, or websites required to complete the assigned activity.
